Coco beach prize - Artothèque de Villeurbanne

Based on the title of a multiple by David Ancelin, "Coco beach", 2014, Macumba night club editions, kept in the collection of the art library of Villeurbanne, this new award leads to the acquisition by the Artothèque de Villeurbanne of an edition presented on the show.

The Artothèque de Villeurbanne is located in the Maison du livre, de l'image et du son (MLIS), a municipal media library, in a remarkable building designed by the Swiss architect Mario Botta. Built as part of the Great Works that marked the French cultural landscape during the Mitterrand era, the MLIS opened its doors in 1988.

RDV/DAC Prize for Design

This prize will reward the most daring curatorial project with the reimbursement of the exhibition fee.

The application consists of the following items:

- 1. a presentation text of your project for Art-o-rama. It will be used for press and communication (1,500 characters maximum);
- 2. list and biographies of the selected artists / designers for the fair;

- 4. any other item you may consider useful for the understanding of your project;
- 5. presentation of your activity (1 page maximum);
- 6. list of the artists / designers edited;
- 7. 2024-2025 programme;
- 8. wire transfer receipt for the application fee.

Participation:

This application form duly completed, signed and submitted on time, cannot be held as a contract for participating in the fair. The final admission will be officially announced by the fair's organizers only, and will entail the entry into force of this agreement.

Each selected exhibitor will be alloted - within all technical possibilities - a booth designed according to the specificities defined by them.

Each exhibitor will receive an exhibitors kit upon final admission to participate in Art-o-rama 2025.

Art.1 - General Rules

The exhibitors who have been selected to participate in Art-o-rama accept, without any reservation, the terms and conditions in the present agreement and shall comply with any other rules and regulations of participation that may be issued by the organizers to supplement these terms and conditions in the interest of the event.

Art.2 - Participation

The selection of the application by the organizers entails the final compliance of the exhibitor to all the rules of the present agreement.

Art.3 - Fees

The exhibitor agrees to pay their application fee before sending their application. The exhibitor also agrees to pay their participation fee upon acceptance of the project at once, upon receipt of the invoice. No exhibitor will be able to settle on its stand before having paid the expenses.

Art.4 - Failure to participate

In case of a participation cancellation, the exhibition fee shall not be refunded except in cases of Force Majeure. The exhibitor shall also reimburse any expenses caused by their application.

Art.5 - Allocation of space

The booth allocation will be made by the organization according to the projects and needs of the exhibitors.

The organizers commit to fit out each booth with minimum equipment (lights, electrical plugs, wifi). Any additional equipment shall be chargeable to the exhibitor. The final decision regarding the event site set-up shall be the organizers'. No claim will be accepted.

Art 6 - Transport, set-up and dismantling

Transport expenses to and from the event are entirely borne by the exhibitor. The installation and the dismantling are made by the exhibitor.

Art.7 - Sales

Sales are allowed, vevertheless, any artwork withdrawn from the booth shall be replaced by another piece equal in quality.

Art.8 - Security

The organizers shall use reasonable endeavour to ensure a guard service outside the opening hours of the event. The exhibitors are responsible for the security of their own equipment.

Art.9 - Insurance

In addition to the compulsary and appropriate liability insurance, the exhibitor shall obtain insurance from their insurance company to hedge other risks such as theft and damage against the artworks and exhibition equipments that may occur during the event, and also during the transport to and from the event. The exhibitor shall fully discharge the organizers from any responsibility in case of fire, breakage, leakage, water damage, or other disturbances, and any other damage not attributable to the organizers or their employees and servants.

Art.10 - Application of the Participation Terms and

conditions

The organizers reserve the right to adjudicate at any time on all the disputed cases, or those not foreseen under these Participation Terms and Conditions. The organizers reserve the right to waive, add or alter any of those terms and conditions in the interest of the event.

Art.11 - Dispute

The parties will facilitate the amicable resolution of the dispute that may occur according to the interpretation or execution of the present agreement. In case of persistent disagreement, the competent court will be that of the jurisdiction of FRÆME, the non-profit structure organizing Art-o-rama.
